CFMD Grant applicants must

- ❖ Be a resident of the United States
- Have a diagnosis of any form of muscular dystrophy or a neuromuscular disorder, including but not limited to the following:

Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, Charcot-Marie Tooth disease, Congenital Muscular Dystrophy, Multiple Sclerosis, Myasthenia gravis, Myopathy, Myositis, Peripheral neuropathy, Spinal muscular atrophy)

Application Process

Download the application form from the CFMD Grant website at http://www.coloradofmd.org/grants/ or request a copy of the application by email (info@coloradofmd.org) or mail.

Submit a completed grant application by email (info@coloradofmd.org) or mail to the Colorado Fund for Muscular Dystrophy address. Attach the required paperwork.

Applications will be reviewed within a week of receipt. You will be notified by email or mail if you are approved to receive the grant.

The maximum request amount per application is \$1,000, payable to a single vendor

If we cannot grant your request for assistance, we will make an effort to suggest other resources that may meet your needs.

Grants may be awarded based on availability of funds
